







Requirements for URMULE:

- Proposal from user
- Label text
- Letter of support from registrant's regulatory affairs department
- Value data
- Submission through Provincial Minor Use Coordinator or Pest Management Centre
- E-index

Requirements for URMUR:

- Active registered in another OECD country, but not in Canada
- Current data package, registered less than 5 years ago
- Registrant must be willing to support, make the submission, and act as liaison between sponsor/user group and PMRA







Registrant submissions

Often the most efficient way to get new weeds on herbicide labels (especially first labels)

- Proponents may still be involved in project, for example by providing data
- Examples:
- Reward (diquat) for water soldier
- Navius (metsulfuron-methyl and aminocyclopyrachlor) for giant hogweed





Emergency use PMRA will respond to emergency pest situations where no control option exists Not an alternative for on-going pest problems Must be a registered active Must not pose unacceptable risk

Emergency use Must have provincial support -Natural Resources, Environment, **Agriculture** Must have registrant support Description of emergency pest situation, proposed pesticide and draft supplemental label and data



- Seek URMULEs, not URMURs
- Keep it close to what is currently registered (rates, USC)
- Get your Provincial Minor Use Coordinator involved
- Work with the registrant
- Work with new compounds
- Do you need a minor use registration?
